

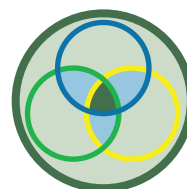

Event Workshops

***Starting a Parent & Infant Program*, presented by Elizabeth Houghtaling:** If you would like to make a life-changing difference for families in just a few hours per week, this workshop is for you! You will learn what a parent-infant program is and how it can provide parents with essential parenting skills based on Montessori Philosophy. You will come away with concrete ideas for setting up a parent-infant program, along with copious ideas for topics for discussion with parents.

***Literary Circles in the Upper Elementary*, presented by Meghan Skotheim:** Join us for examples of great books and the weekly activities that support a vibrant lit circle program.

***The Spiritual Preparation of the Adult*, presented by Hilary Benson:** Give your staff meetings added depth and value by adding activities concerned with spiritual preparation of the Montessori Adult.
